
Nativity School Theater Club

Nativity Catholic School Theater Club Open House 2018 Permission Slip

- I understand Theater Club Open House meetings on October 25, November 1, & November 8 are from 3pm-4:30pm in the FMC. I understand my child may participate on multiple days, but that this form must be turned in no later than the Tuesday before. (For example, if this form is turned in on Oct 23rd, my child may attend Oct 25th and any subsequent days I have indicated. If this form is turned in on Oct 24th, my child may attend Nov 1st and/or Nov 8th.) I will receive a confirmation email the day before each Theater Club Open House my child is signed up for.
- I understand my child will be taken to Extended Care at 4:45p, if he/she has not been picked up. I also understand I am responsible for any fees incurred.
- I understand that my child must attend auditions on the evenings of November 14 or 15, if my child wants to try for a role in the production of *Willy Wonka*. If my child earns a role in *Willy Wonka*, I will be responsible for paying a participation fee of \$65, not including cost of costumes or stage makeup. Students cast in *Willy Wonka* will be expected to attend Theater Club each Thursday, 3pm-4:30pm, November 29 May 9 (excluding holiday breaks). More details will be given to me when my child attends Theater Club Open House.
- I understand there is a possibility that more children will audition than there are roles in the production of *Willy Wonka*, especially in the younger grades. I understand that participation in Theater Club Open House is a wonderful opportunity to learn more about the world of theater and to build my child's confidence in public speaking, but does not guarantee my child a role in the production.
